HIBBERT SWEEPS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS AND SETS SIGHT ON WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

March 22, 2011 - Monster Energy/Arctic Cat's Tucker Hibbert is one-step away from the perfect snocross season. Hibbert won the Pro Super Stock and Pro Open titles over the weekend at the final stop of the ISOC National Snocross Series in Lake Geneva, Wis. Less than 24 hours after accepting his national championship trophies, he boarded a plane for Finland to prepare to defend his FIM Snowcross World Championship title.

This winter marks Hibbert's first full season on snow since 2003. The past six years, he's split his time between snocross and his other passion, AMA motocross and supercross. He's already had a year for the record books claiming his tenth overall ESPN Winter X Games medal and dominating the national tour, winning 11 of the 16 Pro finals and finishing in the top-five in all 16.

Last year at the World Championship in Sweden, Hibbert received a warm welcome for his first event overseas and became the first American in history to win the prestigious event.
